# the bachelor's degree programme

**(Affiliated to Nagaland University)**

The College offers courses for graduate degrees in both Arts, Commerce and Management. In the Degree programme, students have the option to take up Honours in a specific subject. A minimum of 45% in the subject concerned in their HSSLC exam is required to take up Honours.

The duration of the Degree course is three years and comprised of six semesters. Students must have 75% attendance and score a minimum 45% in their internal assessment to sit for their end semester exams.

Important: Pass mark for the semester system is 45%. Students must secure pass mark in both internal assessment and end semester exam. A student is allowed a maximum of 2 back-papers to proceed to the next semester.

## Structured Courses to be offered for IDC, SEC & VAC Papers under National Education Policy (NEP) at Tetso College

Tetso College, an affiliating institute of Nagaland University, offers the Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) in alignment with the newly introduced National Education Policy (NEP)–2020 principles.

The undergraduate degree will be of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple exit options within this period, with appropriate certifications.

The following options available to students are:

- UG certificate after completing 1 year in a discipline or field including vocational and professional areas
- UG diploma after 2 years of study
- Bachelor's degree after a 3-year programme
- 4 year multidisciplinary Bachelor's programme

The FYUGP also allows academic flexibility to the students to study the subjects/courses of their choice and for their mobility to different institutions. It promotes experiential learning through seminars, practicum, internships, field practice, projects, community engagement, and more to enhance the learning process.

Additionally, the programme focuses on courses that are interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary. This will facilitate the students to opt for different inter-disciplinary, intradisciplinary, and skill-based courses depending upon their interests.


